MEMORY VERSE—GENESIS 5:24

"And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him."

- To walk with God is to have a personal relationship and fellowship with God.
- Enoch's walk with God included:
 - Talking to God
 - Listening to God
 - Spending time with God
 - Thinking about God
 - Telling others about God
 - Obeying God
 - Loving God
 - Having faith in God
 - Pleasing God
- As a result of Enoch walking with God, he did not have to die a physical death. "By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God" (Hebrews 11:5).
- Enoch reaped what he sowed. His relationship with God resulted in being transported to Heaven.
- We too will reap the benefits of being a child of God. Someday, every believer in Jesus will be transported to Heaven (1 Thessalonians 4:14-18) (1 Corinthians 15:51-52).
