GOD LOOKS ON THE HEART

Family Devotion — Lesson 48

MEMORY VERSE — PSALM 95:3

“For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.”

- God is not only good, He is GREAT! He is the great King above all gods. Nothing compares to Him or even comes close. *“There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside thee: neither is there any rock like our God”* (1 Sam. 2:2).
- A king is someone who rules with power and authority. Jesus is the “KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS” (Rev. 19:16).
 - *“And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth”* (Mt. 28:18)
 - *“Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen”* (1 Tim. 1:17).
 - *“Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords”* (1 Tim. 6:15).
- Every person who has trusted Jesus as Saviour has Jesus living in his heart. *“That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith...”* (Eph. 3:17). Jesus may be living inside of you, but is He the King of your heart? If He is the King of your heart, He will be the King of your life. Here are some questions to ask:
 - 1) Do I think about Jesus?
 - 2) Do I obey Jesus?
 - 3) Do I love Jesus?
 - 4) Do I live to please Jesus?
 - 5) Do I give things up for Jesus?
 - 6) Do others see Jesus in my life?



QUESTIONS TO DISCUSS

- What are some things we should not have in our hearts?
- What will happen if we fill our hearts with the things of the world? (Jesus will have no room to influence us.)



PRAYER TIME

- Confess the things you have in your heart that should not be there.
- Tell Jesus you want Him to be the King and Lord of your life.



CHALLENGE

- Every morning this week, before you start your day, tell Jesus that He is the King of your heart and life.
