# GOD'S POWER IS FOR GOD'S PURPOSE

### Family Devotion — Lesson 70

#### MEMORY VERSE — AMOS 3:3

***“Can two walk together, except they be agreed?”***

- The answer to this question is no. To “walk” means to have fellowship. To agree means to think the same thing. We must agree with God to have fellowship with Him.
- God empowers his people to walk with Him.
- “That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious POWER, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;” (Col. 1:10-11).
- God gives His children power:
  - 1) to walk worthy (are you?)
  - 2) to be fruitful (are you?)
  - 3) to increase in knowledge (are you?)
  - 4) to be patient (are you?)
  - 5) to be joyful (are you?)
- “According as his divine POWER hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue” (2 Pet. 1:3).
- “I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing” (Jn. 15:5).
